On May 2, 2017 the Department began consultations on the proposed regulatory changes to create a standalone commercial licence for Albacore tuna, as well as potential changes to the licensing regime for Albacore Tuna. A discussion guide and questionnaire was sent out either as an email or via hard copy mail to all CT licence holders. Those documents outline the proposed regulatory changes to create a standalone Tuna licence and discusses potential changes to the current Tuna licensing regime.

The deadline for responses on these proposed changes has been extended to **November 15**, **2017**.
